### **European Union**

EU-CLP or REGULATION (EC) No 1272/2008 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 16 December 2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures (CLP), amending and repealing Directives 67/548/EEC (Dangerous Substance Directive) and 1999/45/EC, and amending Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 concerning Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH as amended).
